Title: Standing Strong in the Face of Fear:

Scripture: Daniel 3

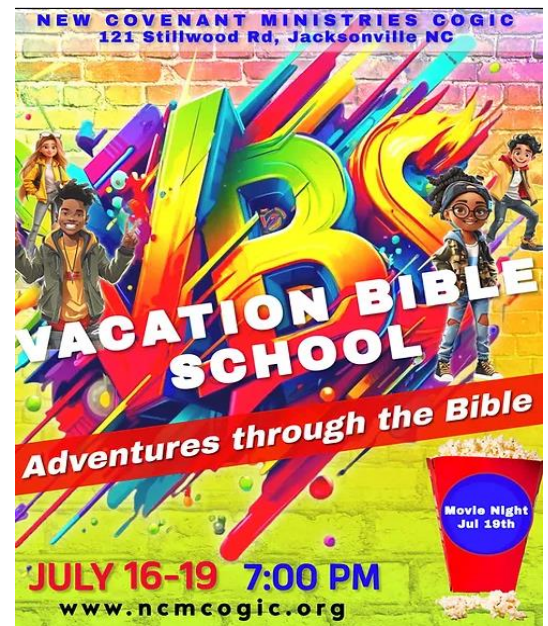
Objective: To explore the story of Daniel’s friends, Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, and how they demonstrated bravery and faith in the face of adversity.
